IVID TREATED WATER SYSTEM:

Ione Band of Miwok Indians Water System Improvements Draft Engineering Report: A presentation was given by Brian McCauley of MKN & Associates, Inc. on Preliminary Alternatives Analysis Results for system consolidation. The board will take action in January on the preferred alternative.

IVID GENERAL:

Monthly Water Supply Report: The lake elevation as of 11/30/22 was 428.9'. Total water in storage was 10,292 Ac-Ft (47% capacity). November irrigation water demand was 227.4 Ac-Ft; treated water demand was 5.18 Ac-Ft. Rainfall July 2022 – June 2023 was 1.88''.

Preliminary FY 2023 Budget Discussion: Staff presented a first draft of the budget.

Review Draft Reimbursement Policy: The GM presented a draft reimbursement policy for staff time reimbursement, material procurement, and work orders.

CONCESSION REPORT: Trout season has started, they are stocking a wide variety of trout; water clarity is poor; working on boundary fence.

COMMENTS: Director Ohm discussed online bill pay options; Directors Jess and Gonzalez reported on the Amador County Groundwater Management Authority meeting.
